CHILDREN COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT (This is part of their life)

I have talked to the kids and have informed me on all what they do while at home. They differ in activities according to their to their sex.

LET ME START WITH BOYS:-

- Boys participate in cleaning their farms ready for cultivation.
- Boys participate in harvesting maize, rice and groundnuts and carrying the foods to the food store.
- Boys participate in weeding farms.
- Boys help in collecting fire wood and sometimes they look after the cows, goats and sheep of their guardians.
- Boys also help in making hoes and planting of trees which include shady trees and fruits trees.
- They clean the environment where they live.

GIRLS DO THE FOLLOWING DUTIES WHITE AT HOME:-

- They do the cleaning of the home compound and surroundings.
- Help in cooking for the family.
- Help in collecting water from the well.
- Help in collecting fire wood from the forest/bush.
- Help in washing utensils and keeping them safely.
- Help in cleaning the house and all things bought for that.
- They also decorate rooms by putting flowers and ornaments.
- They also help in preparing food and fruits before meals.
- They participate in team work when needed or requires to do so by the community.

USE OF THE VHP HOUSE AND THINGS.

It is good to let you know that we were permitted to use all the equipments eating utensils, tables, chairs and water on every 30th day of every month. The cooks of VHP prepare the food for the kids on every 30th day of every month and kids eat and play together with the small kids who live in the home (VHP). They prepare and arrange tables, chairs and all needed items for the day.
