Refurbishment Phase I (September 2010)

Regent Primary School is in desperate need of refurbishing. Apart from many other hardships, children have had to endure a leaking roof and flooded classrooms for many years. AKIN began fundraising during late 2009 and has been able to raise enough funds to refurbish the school roof.

Fundraising initiatives included the sale of chocolate Santa figurines during Christmas 2009, a raffle during Easter 2010, a bingo night during May 2010 and the ongoing sale/auction of retail vouchers throughout the year. The dream became a reality in August 2010 when Phase I of the school refurbishment was completed.

The roof and ceiling needed urgent work, they were in a terrible state.....



AKIN awarded the contract to refurbish the school roof to a well known local contractor during August 2010. The construction company had already worked for many international Non Governmental Organisations (NGOs), such as Medicos del Mundo. They completed the works quickly and to a high standard of quality in time for the beginning of the new school term in September 2010.

Approximately 50% of all the timber roof members were replaced with new ones

A large section of the roof was replaced with new galvanised corrugated iron roofing sheets.



All the damaged ceiling coverings and frames were replaced and painted.
